This includes a number of Ironkey secure flash drives, specifically, the IronKey S200 and D200 devices, and Ironkey Defender F100, F150 and H100 secure USB flash and hard drives.

Solution

 IronKey Personal and Enterprise S200 and D200 users should update their devices to IronKey software update release 2.5.2.0. Please refer to the following Knowledge Base article for information regarding updating your device: How to update your IronKey device.

Please note that the following Ironkey secure USB devices are not affected and are compatible with Mac OS X 10.8 Mountain Lion:

- IronKey x250 devices
- McAfee ePO managed devices
- Ironkey Defender F200 and H200 biometric devices (when using biometrics for access)
